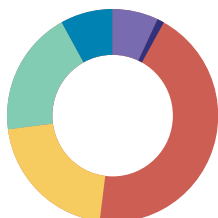

- 55+ and nursing home eligible
- Live in a PACE Service Area
- Can live in community safely with PACE support
- 99% are eligible for Medi-Cal
